RAINY *Season!*

The rainy season has brought heavy rains and typhoons to many parts of Laguna. As a result, several communities have experienced flooding, canceled classes and work, and difficulties in earning a daily income.



For many families, a rainy day means more than just staying at home. It can mean missing a day of work, losing income, dealing with flooded homes, and struggling to provide food for their families.

DESPITE THESE CHALLENGES, WE CONTINUE TO BELIEVE THAT THIS IS ALSO AN OPPORTUNITY TO SHOW GOD'S LOVE IN PRACTICAL WAYS.

RELIEF EFFORT

As a family in Christ, we are planning to reach out to at least **100 families** who have been affected by the heavy rains and flooding in our area. We are preparing relief goods containing basic necessities that can help families get through this difficult season. More than simply providing food and supplies, **we want every family to know that they are not forgotten and that God cares for them.**

We are raising \$1,000 to provide food relief packs for at least 100 families affected by the heavy rains and flooding in CamCam, Railway and Isla Bisaya communities. Each family will receive a **\$10 relief pack containing rice, canned goods, noodles and coffee to help provide some relief during this challenging season.**

At this time, we have already raised \$132.50. We still need to raise \$867.50 to reach our goal. Every contribution, no matter the amount, makes a difference! Together, we can turn this difficult season into an **opportunity to demonstrate the love of Christ. Will you join us?**
